Over 20 artificial reefs are maintained by Lee County, which attracts copious amounts of fish and other sea creatures, giving divers the chance to experience this sea life in their natural habitat. Divers have the chance to explore several shipwrecks off the coast of Fort Myers including The Bayronto and The Baja California. Snorkelers and divers alike will have the opportunity to view underwater life such as:

- Grouper
- Snapper
- Stone Crabs
- Shrimp
